## **RETREAT MASTER:**

Father Dan Leary, current Pastor of Jesus the Divine Word, Huntingtown, MD, has been leading women's retreats for 12 years. Women's prayer groups in Gaithersburg and Huntingtown were formed as the result of spiritual growth and healing following his retreats. Father Leary's focus on drawing men and women closer to Christ through the Sacraments and a formed prayer life have helped many to grow in their faith year after year. Father Leary attended Mount St. Mary's Seminary and was ordained in 1997.

## **RETREAT INFORMATION:**

- Malvern's retreat fee (\$192 per person) includes a private room with a sink in each room and shared bathrooms on each floor. Six meals are included, starting with dinner on Friday night and ending with lunch on Sunday. The supplemental retreat fee (\$14 per person) covers gratuities, retreat materials, snacks, bottled water, and coffee.
- Because of the distance to the retreat center, we will offer coach bus service from Huntingtown, MD for an additional \$50 per person (optional). **Buses will leave the JDW parking lot at 2:00 p.m. on Friday and return approx. 5:00 p.m. on Sunday.** We ask that you strongly consider this option. Enjoy the ride - and some special prayer time - with your sisters in Christ.
- The schedule provides for three Masses - Friday night, Saturday, and Sunday morning - as well as opportunities for Confession, Eucharistic Adoration, Healing Prayers, and Praise and Worship.

## **SILENT DAY:**

Due to the positive feedback we received after last year's retreat, we have decided to offer a "silent day" again this year. On Saturday, Mass and talks will be conducted as usual, but meals and time in-between will be held in silence. The primary purpose of the silence is to foster an atmosphere in which we may be led to a personal encounter with God. Our world provides little time or space for reflection, prayer and contemplation. Silence is a gift we give ourselves and others who are with us. We ask that you do your best to respect and protect each other's quiet time with God throughout the day on Saturday.
