The *Good News Preschool* is a ministry of Jesus the Divine Word Parish in Huntingtown, Maryland. It is a non-profit organization. Our preschool is open to all of God's little children, with first preference being given to those families currently enrolled at Good News Preschool and then to the parishioners of Jesus the Divine Word Parish. The program is then open to the general public.

It is the mission of *Good News Preschool* to promote the social, emotional, cognitive, motor and spiritual development of three and four year old children within a fun-filled, loving, Catholic atmosphere. Our learning environment is one in which the uniqueness of each child is emphasized, while offering developmentally appropriate activities in the instructional areas of Math, Science, Reading Readiness, Social Studies, and Religion.

Good News Preschool offers programs for both three and four year old children. Our four-year-old program is held on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. There is a class limit of 15 children in this program. Children must be 4 years old by September 1, 2012. The three-year-old program is held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. There is a class limit of 12 children in this program. Children must be 3 years old by September 1, 2012. *All children must be completely toilet trained before beginning school.*

Tuition for the four-year-old program is \$220 per month. The tuition for the three-year-old program is \$155 per month. There is a 25% discount for additional children in the family. Tuition is due on the first of each month. The first month's tuition payment and a registration fee of \$50 are due at registration. **Both are non-refundable.**

The staff of *Good News Preschool* encourages communication and cooperation between school and home to make your child's preschool experience the best it can be. Our newsletter, "*Good News*", will be sent home monthly by email to provide parents with the upcoming curriculum and special events. Parents are asked to send their child in with a nutritious snack and drink each day.
